



USJ Student Application for September 2021- June 2022

The application should be submitted **as soon as possible, but no later than September 11, 2021**. The sooner you submit your application, the sooner you start receiving information on scholarships and internships.

All programming will be via zoom during the first semester, except for outdoor social activities, if any. We will be closely following the CDC and state guidelines and if it is safe, USJ will consider having its second-semester programming in-person at Justice High School.

United for Social Justice (USJ) is a 501(c)3 non-profit organization. For the past 12 years, USJ has helped hundreds of first-generation students achieve their dream of higher education. **Our programs are free to our students.**

Students accepted into the USJ program will benefit from:

1. **Road to College Workshop Program:** Interactive workshops facilitated by professionals and experts from local universities on subjects such as: finding scholarships, college loans and financial literacy, writing your college essay, developing a strong resume, STEM 101, College 101, career panel, self advocacy, choosing a college, college admissions, and more.
2. **Mentoring Program:** one-on-one mentoring where students can receive mentoring from a college student or a professional in academics and the college application process.
3. **USJ Scholarship Opportunity** (for USJ seniors only): Every year USJ awards scholarship money to selected seniors who have attended USJ events, embody USJ's spirit, and apply for the scholarship.
4. **A support network:** Our group of students will find a sense of family in our programs through the individualized attention and guidance they will receive from the board members, the facilitators, their mentors, and their peers. Many of our students have called USJ a "familia" or family because we also create recreational/community activities for our students to bond (soccer tournament and team building activities), we follow-up on the students' progress, and we provide students with additional scholarship, program, and internship information.

Students accepted into the program are expected to:

1. Be in 11th or 12th grade in any high school and submit the enclosed application. Sophomores and freshmen will be accepted as well, but please keep in mind our program is designed for juniors and seniors.
2. Commit to attend and actively participate in all monthly USJ events throughout the school year.
3. Be responsive to our emails and evite requests for USJ events and to communication from his/her/their mentor.
4. Provide their own transportation to events, particularly when and if we resume out activities in person.



5. Turn on their screens during sessions.
